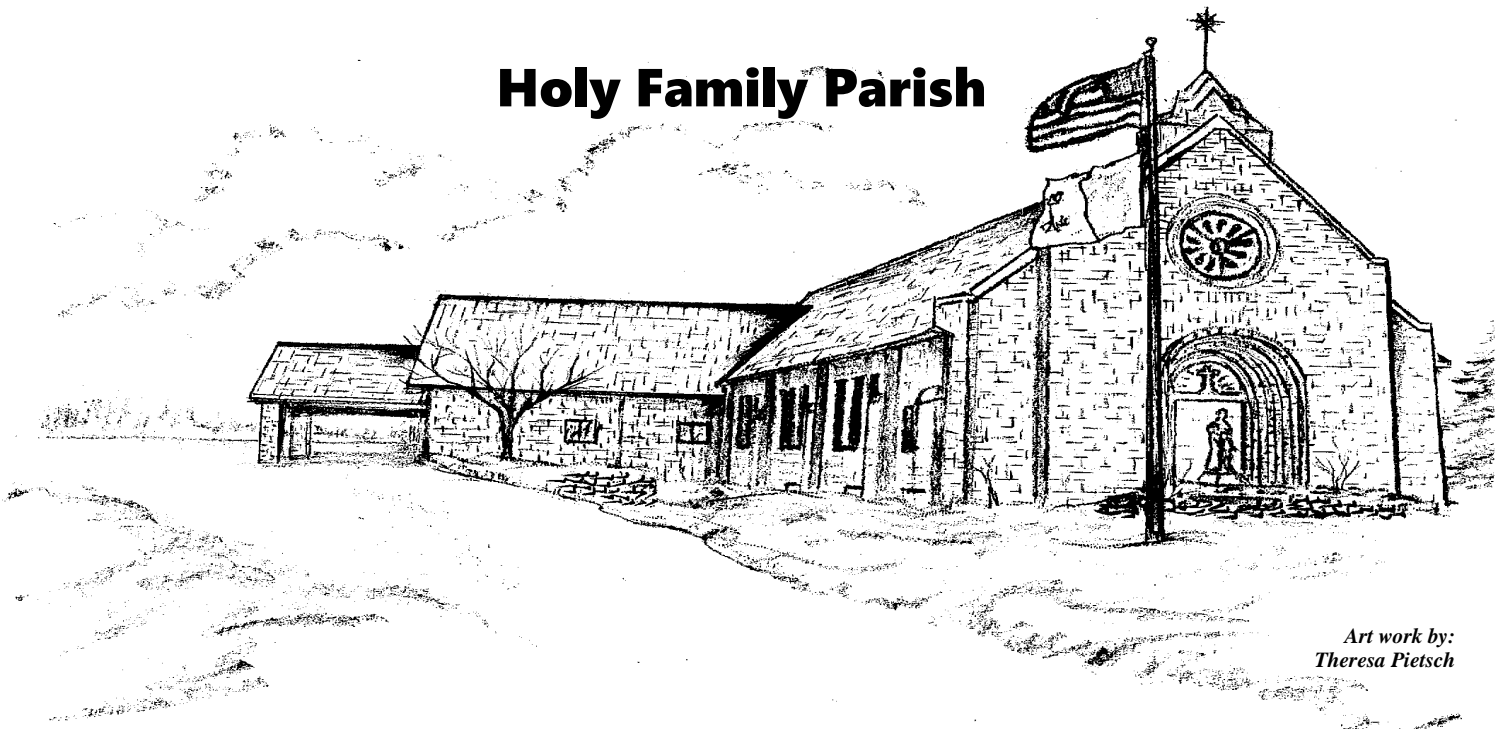

ROOF UPDATE

The company that is installing the new metal roofs on our parish facilities is Kulp’s of Stratford, Wisconsin. They have been really working with our parish through the project. The workers have been amazing at doing a great job and have really kept our grounds clean every day. They should finish by the end of next week. The total cost of the project is \$168,239. We have already paid Kulp’s \$84,119.40 with a balance of \$84,119.60 due in September.

We had \$71,309 on hand from “Our Faith in the Future” campaign back in 2010. Our parishioners have held various fundraisers over the years raising \$5,816.58. Holy Family applied for and was given a \$5,000 Community Grant and we have \$55,435 in pledges from 86 families. Other people have donated in one way or another giving us \$3,186 with earned interest of \$2,822.43 on the money in the savings and a NEEDY LOAN from the diocese of \$24,669.99. That totals \$168,239.

Thanks very much to all of those who have made one-time donation or a pledge to defray the cost of this project. If you have not already done so, perhaps you might reconsider as the project is now something actually taking place and not simply proposed.

Bishop Doerfler will again send a direct mailing to all registered households in early September to kick off the UP Catholic Services Appeal. Like previous years, the “first ask” mailing will include a personalized cover letter from the Bishop, a “Gifts at Work” newsletter and a personalized pledge card and reply envelope for parishioners to return to their parish.
