#### **Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament with the Stations of the Cross**

Along with the praying of the stations we adore the exposed Blessed Sacrament and receive the blessing (benediction) of Christ present, (body, blood, soul and divinity). Attendance improves weekly.
