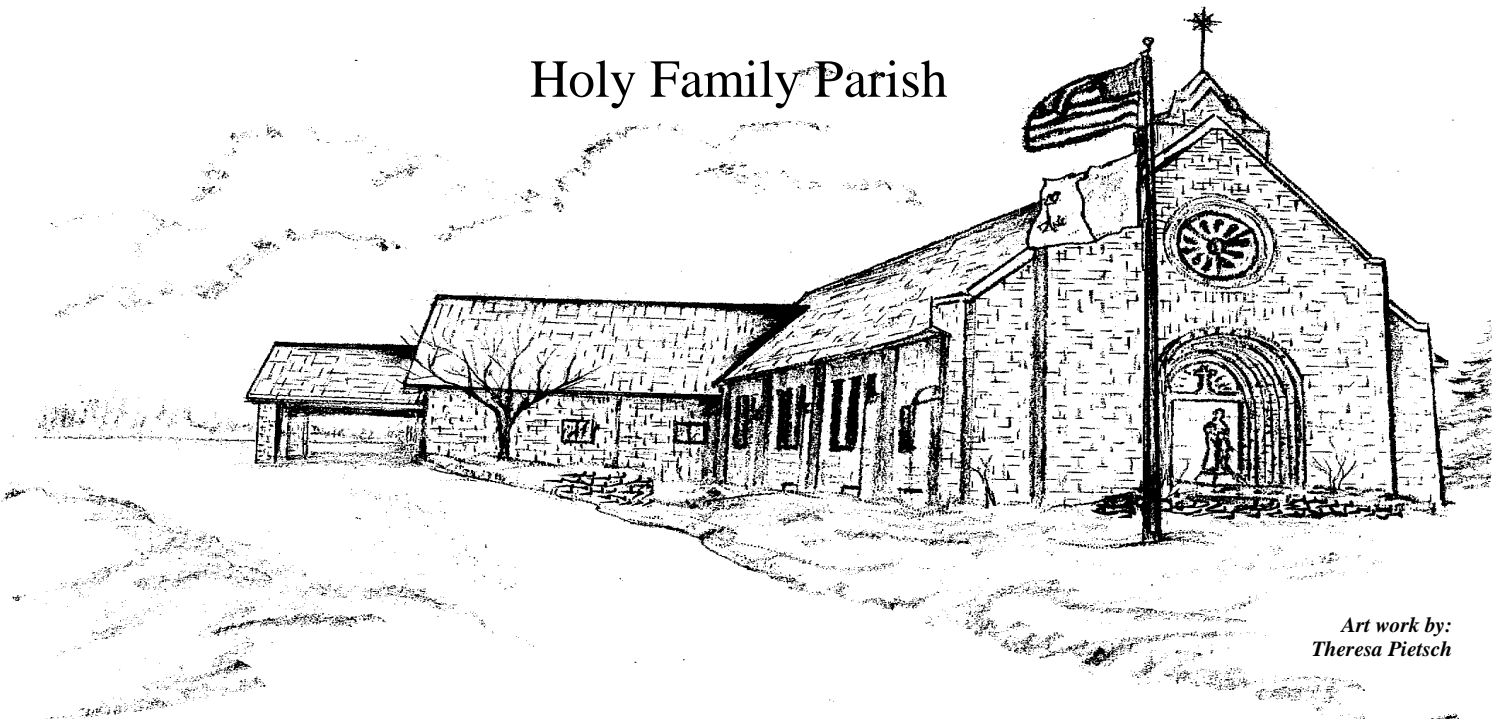

Saturday 3:00 to 3:30 P.M.

30 minutes before Mass on Tuesday and Friday
or by appointment

Sacrament of Marriage

Notice of six months is required

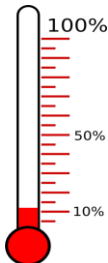

Sincere thanks to the **47** parishioners who made donations and pledges so far to our roof project totaling **\$28,615**. That leaves us with a balance of **\$62,496**.
